PRIMARY SCHOOL

LICEF PRIMARY SCHOOL follows the 2013 Zambia Education Curriculum Framework (2013 ZECF) incorporating components of the Cambridge syllabus. Subjects offered in the curriculum include the following:

1. LITERACY AND LANGUAGES

Under which the following are offered:

i. ENGLISH learning program which comprises the following components:

- Composition
- Comprehension
- Punctuation
- Grammar
- Spelling
- Phonic
- Handwriting
- Reading
- Book Review
- Library Activities

ii. **CINYANJA** which is taught as per Ministry of Education (MoE) guideline policy and is also broken down into similar components as English language.

iii. **ARABIC LANGUAGE** is taught alongside Cinyanja as an optional subject. It is mandatory for Muslim pupils, nevertheless, pupils who wish to study this subject are free to take it.

iv. **EXTENSION READING:** Licef School also boasts of the Extension Reading Department which uses a comprehensive reading scheme to provide quality and extensive reading lessons in order to develop good academic and independent reading skills in pupils. Furthermore, the department also offers library services to Grades 1 to 4.

2. CREATIVE AND TECHNOLOGY STUDIES (CTS)

This subject is comprised of **Art, Information and Communication Technology (ICT) and Physical Education (P.E)**. These subjects are handled by specialized teachers and are offered from Grade 3-7 classes.
